


## SCA Member Discount Program (MDP) for the term 2021 - December 2022

In this document, Singapore Chefs' Association (SCA) Members are referred to as "Members", and companies providing discounts or other privileges are referred to as "Partners".

- 1. Partners will commit to provide discounts or other privileges agreed upon with SCA, throughout the term till December 2022. Should it wish to cease or make changes to the arrangement, it should inform SCA's Membership In-charge.
- 2. Members may check the SCA website, Singaporechefs.com, for the latest list of MDP Partners. Discounts and privileges, with their applicable terms and conditions by the Partners, are extended to all categories of SCA Membership (SCA/SJCC/SPA), excluding SCA Corporate Members.
- 3. SCA shall not be responsible for the quality, merchantability or the fitness for any purpose or any other aspect of the products and/or services provided by our Partners. All disputes about quality or performance of products and/or services shall be resolved directly with the Partner. SCA shall not at any time be responsible or held liable for any injury, loss, damage or harm suffered by or in connection with any products and/or services provided by our Partners. Partners reserve the right, at reasonable discretion, to vary or amend the terms and conditions of the discounts or privileges.
- 4. Members shall check with the Partner again on the discount arrangement before making purchases , when making a reservation or before dining at their establishment, to avoid any disputes.
- 5. Members shall prove their membership validity by producing without demand, their Electronic Membership Card, which can be found on their Glueup app¹ and glueup.com personal profile page². Vendors shall reserve the right not to extend any discounts to Members who do not produce their Electronic Membership Card, or whose membership has expired³. (See annex for examples of ¹, ², ³)
- 6. Since 2020, SCA has ceased usage and has also stopped issuing hardcopy Membership Cards. SCA has transited to using the Glueup Membership management platform to issue members with Electronic Membership Cards. Should a person present a hardcopy Membership Card (old membership card), his or her membership would have had expired and is not a current member of SCA.
- 7. Partners may ask the Member to produce his/her NRIC as a form of secondary identification to check against the electronic membership card. In such instances, Partners are not allowed to retain any personal information, and is required to return the NRIC immediately, under Singapore's PDPA law.
- 8. SCA Membership cannot be shared and is non-transferrable. Partners who suspect of any shared/transferred membership, or fraudulent use, may report the matter, together with the Member's Membership Number<sup>4</sup> to SCA's Membership In-charge. (See annex for examples of <sup>4</sup>)
